

Our Rooms

Sleep soundly in one of our 16 uniquely appointed Maine inn guest rooms overlooking either John's Bay or the wild and whimsical perennial gardens. Each room is uniquely appointed and all include private bathrooms and telephones. Our seasonal nightly room rates – ranging from \$175 to \$350 – are based on double occupancy and are inclusive of a full country breakfast and afternoon tea.



The Area

Directions

1. Take Maine Turnpike (I-95) North to Exit 44 (I-295 North). Continue on I-295 through Portland to Exit 28 (Coastal Route 1 to Brunswick).
2. You will be on Route 1 for about 30 miles –through Brunswick, Bath & Wiscasset, eventually exiting at Newcastle/ Damariscotta (to Route 129/130).
3. Bear right at the blinking red light, and continue through Damariscotta village.
4. Turn right onto Route 129/130. After about three miles this road divides. Take the left fork (Route 130) and continue another 11 miles to the Inn.

Sea Glass

Soothing and serene, this corner chamber on the second floor offers garden views, a charming queen-sized iron bed and crisp white linens. Features include a private bath and comfy striped chairs.

Ale Wives

Painted a cheery blue with bright floral accents, this spacious suite features hardwood floors, a queen bed, gas fireplace, private bath and a separate sitting room with daybed and plush chair. Accommodates up to three guests.



Longliners

Nautically themed with a water view, this third-floor corner room offers a queen four-poster bed, private bath, sitting area, gas fireplace and great maritime artifacts – including a swordfish scrimshaw.

Little Castaway

Secluded with a private entrance and private porch, this room is a great option for honeymooners. Features include a king bed, gas fireplace, comfy wicker chairs, private bath and an antique bureau.

Occupying the entire second floor of the converted barn this folksy suite features a living space with gas fireplace, full kitchen, dining area, views of the grounds and cathedral ceilings throughout.
